The incumbents will participate in the planning of our annual audit of the State of California's financial statements and related activities, interact regularly with accounting personnel at a variety of state agencies, and work with State Auditor staff and management in a collaborative and effective manner. The Senior Financial Auditor III will supervise subordinate Seniors and Auditor Evaluators to ensure that audits are conducted in accordance with professional auditing standards, financial statements are presented in conformity with generally accepted accounting



principles, and the focus of the team aligns with the mission of the State Auditor.


### The Ideal Candidates
